I am very excited to be the new coordinator of the University Network and to be the director of the Campus Fellowship Program of the Institute of Jewish Ideas and Ideals. The University Network provides a forum for students to ask questions and explore issues pertaining to Orthodox Judaism and to converse with other students about Orthodoxy.
