1. Please make sure that we have your correct mailing address on file. You may go to our website, jewishideas.org, and check your My Account page. We mailed out the new issue of Conversations (Orthodoxy and Ethics) in early September, and I hope that you've received your copy.

2. We have a number of members in various countries e.g. Israel, Turkey, Italy, France, Brazil, Australia etc. It is very expensive to mail Conversations to these members, but we are glad to do so. However, sometimes these copies have been returned to us due to incorrect mailing addresses that were given to us. Whenever copies are returned, we will not re-send them; so please be extra sure that we have your correct address on file.

Representatives will take responsibility for trying to schedule a program through their Hillel or other Jewish student organization, dealing with a theme relating to the interests of the Institute for Jewish Ideas and Ideals. We'll provide a speaker at no cost to the sponsoring organization, except for travel expenses. Representatives will also spread the word about the Institute to fellow students, encouraging them to enrol in the University Network.
